## CODE OF ETHICS

This code is designed

- to ensure the elements of enjoyment and satisfaction that come from playing/being involved in Cricket are maintained;
- to constantly remind administrators, coaches, captains and players that Cricket must be administered, taught and played for the good of those people who wish to play the game.

The codes are not an exclusive statement for the conduct of Cricket. They are a statement of ethics adopted by the SDCC.

### SDCC Player's Code

1. Play for the enjoyment.
2. Play within the Laws of the Game of Cricket.
3. Never argue with the umpire's decisions. Let your captain ask any necessary questions.
4. Control your temper - no mouthing off.
5. Work equally hard for yourself and for your team - your team's performance will benefit and so will your own.
6. Be a good sport. Applaud ALL good play, whether by your team or by your opponent.
7. Co-operate with your coach, captain, team-mates, umpire and opponents, for without them you don't have a game.
8. Develop team respect for the ability of opponents, as well as the judgement of umpires and opposing captains.
9. Keep on-field chatter to the opposition to a minimum – definitely no sledging with a personal nature.
10. There will be a 'zero tolerance' policy to for ALL comments that are racial or religious or that have to do with sexual orientation. This will be irrespective of whether they be during games, at training or at any club-sanctioned functions.
